‘It’s important to have more classrooms because families in Africa are extensive and after the war there was a greater concentration of people in the cities.



Although there are classrooms, they’re not sufficient and there are still children who are not in the teaching system. They do not have the opportunity to study.

Churches are building classrooms but it is not enough. It’s about the integral mission of the church: Jesus Christ loved; He loved children and Jesus Christ taught us to have love each for the other’.
